Occasional work in conjunction with the Technical Assistant and with faculty working on the long-term environmental databases.

Qualifications: Preference given to Williams College students who are self-motivated, reliable, and work well independently with minimal supervision. Experience sought in laboratory analysis and database work; organizational skills, data collection and field experience is desirable.
